# Regional Tourism Product Plan (1)

- During the planning in 2006 and 2007 it was established that the HU-HR border region has great potential for sustainable tourism.
- The idea of the Mura-Drava-Danube eco-tourism region manifested in an independent area of intervention within the Programme (AoI 1.2).
- Instead of creating a 'programme within the programme', a two-step approach was used.





# Regional Tourism Product Plan (2)

- A partnership of 4 organisations won the funding and prepared the RTPP from February 2010 to June 2011.
- The output is a 650 page document analysing the tourism development possibilities of the HU and HR border region. It is accompanied by a GIS database.
- For future applicants the RTPP was condensed into a Tourism Handbook, published in September 2011.





# The ,De-mine HU-HR' Project

- Total EU funding from the Programme: 3.000.000 EUR.
- LB: Croatian Mine Action Center, Hungarian PP: Baranya County Police Headquarters.
- Survey, marking, demining and rehabilitation of areas as previously identified for the application.
- Total demined area along the border: 2.629.983 m<sup>2</sup>
- Altogether 152 mines and UXO-s have been found and destroyed (121 pieces of ERW in Croatia; 31 pieces of ERW in Hungary).





## Projects in Numbers

- Number of Calls for Proposals: 1 in 2009, 1 in 2010 and 1 in 2011.
- Total number of applications: 315.
- Total number of supported projects: 169.
- Number of Project Partner organisations in these projects: 242 HU and 282 HR.
- Spent EU funding: 49.494.310,60 EUR which represents a spending level of 97,23%.

#### The INTERREG V-A HU-HR CP

- A total of 60,8 million EUR of EU contribution.
- Four Priority Axes:
  - Economic development (9,96 mEUR)
  - Sustainable use of natural and cultural assets (35,78 mEUR)
  - Cooperation (5,72 mEUR)
  - Education (5,72 mEUR)
- Same institutional setup as 2017-2013.






## The 1<sup>st</sup> Call for Proposals

- Published on 29 February 2016 with a submission deadline of 31 May 2016.
- 208 applications submitted for a total of 82.994.104 EUR, three times the amount available (26.528.785 EUR).
- Project selection: 2-3 March 2017.
- 54 projects selected for a total of 23.383.107 EUR of EU funding. 76 HU and 100 HR partner organisations.
- Most funding dedicated to: bicycle roads (7.116.477 EUR) and tourism attractions (7.306.966 EUR).

# The ,De-mine HU-HR II' project

- Total EU funding from the Programme: 3 million EUR.
- LB: Croatian Mine Action Center, Hungarian partners: Baranya County Police Headquarters and Duna-Dráva National Park Directorate.
- Demining of minefields on the Croatian side, nontechnical and technical survey of UXO-s on the Hungarian side, nature rehabilitation activities on both sides.
- Total area to be rehabilitated: 1.456.319 m<sup>2</sup>.





# The ,B-Light Scheme' project

- Total EU funding from the Programme: 10 million EUR.
- LB: HAMAG-BICRO, other main partners: 4 Croatian county development agencies, 3 Hungarian enterprise development agencies.
- ERDF subsidy to co-operating SME-s from 30.000 to 135.000 EUR per undertaking.
- Two-stage application process with project-generation support from the LB and its partners.
- 15 September 2017: 53 project concepts submitted.
